INSTRUCTION FOR CANDIDATES

- SSC – CGL exams are conducted for **Group-B** and **Group-C** officer posts.

Education Qualification :

- **Bachelor's Degree** from a recognized University or equivalent

Age

- The SSC CGL age limit is a **minimum of 18** and a **maximum of different posts years**. Apart from this, there are certain age relaxation criteria for the reserved group of candidates.

Mode of Selection:

1 Minimum qualifying marks in Tier-I, Section-I, Section-II & Module-I of Section-III of Paper-I of Tier-II & Paper-II of Tier-II Examination are as follows:

- UR : 30%
- OBC/ EWS : 25%
- All other categories : 20%

2 Maximum percentage of errors allowed (i.e. minimum qualifying standards) in Module-II of Section-III of Paper-I of Tier-II Examination i.e. DEST are as follows:

- UR : 20%
- OBC/ EWS : 25%
- All other categories : 30%

3. Based on the marks scored in Tier-I i.e. Computer Based Examination, candidates will be shortlisted, category-wise, to appear in Tier-II Examination.

4. Tier-II Examination will be conducted for all the candidates qualified in Tier-I. In Tier-II, all the candidates will be required to appear in all three sections of Paper-I.

5. In Paper-I of Tier-II, it will be mandatory for the candidates to qualify all the sections.

6. Based on the aggregate performance in Section-I and Section-II of Paper-I of Tier-II Examination, candidates will be shortlisted for evaluation of Section-III of Paper-I of Tier-II Examination.

7. Section-III of Paper-I of Tier-II is qualifying in nature, in other words both modules i.e. Computer Knowledge Test and DEST are qualifying in nature.

8. Merit list will be prepared on the basis of overall performance of candidates in Tier-II Examination only.
