GENERAL INSTRUCTION :

(i) The questions in the examination will be bilingual (Hindi & English) except for the Language papers which will be in the language concerned only.

(ii) The Board, in order to achieve qualitative selection and to recruit the best talent available, has fixed the following minimum qualifying marks for different categories (UR/SC/ST/OBC/EWS/P.W.D/EX-SM) :-

General/EWS : 40%

OBC (Delhi) : 35%

SC/ST/PH (PwD) : 30%

Ex-servicemen will be given 5% relaxation in their respective categories subject to a minimum of 30%.

(iii) For minimum qualifying marks in Tier-I Examinations will be applicable only in r/o Section-B which is domain subject specific. There will not be any minimum qualifying marks in

Section-A. However, combined aggregate marks of both Section-A & Section-B will be reckoned for preparing the final merit list.

(iv) Evaluation of Tier-I examination will be undertaken based on cumulative marks of Section A & B.

(v) Negative Marking will be applicable and deduction of 0.25 marks will be made for each wrong Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) answer.

(vi) Skill Test / Endurance Test will be taken as per requirement of job.

(vii) Marks scored by candidates in the Computer Based Examination will be normalized by using the formula by DSSSB and such normalized scores will be used to determine final merit and selection
